Please register as soon as you can so we can make proper preparations for our group.

# What to bring:

- Camp Savoy is primitive camping on private property. Trail Life will provide water, firewood (although you're welcome to bring more) and port-a-pottys.
- Please bring all gear needed to camp for your family including tents, sleeping pads and bags, food, cooking utensils, flashlights, etc. If you need help with a full list, please reach out to us.
- We ask that you and your children use these campouts for a time to step away from electronics. We understand there may be special circumstances and ask that you use them discreetly when needed. Using a phone's camera to save memories is of course an exception to that request.

**Tentative Schedule:** In our experience the children quickly find ways to enjoy the outdoors without requiring a strict activity plan, so we like to allow for this free time. We will have some planned activities on Saturday and will announce a final schedule closer to the date.

From Frisco, Take Preston Rd (Hwy 289) North to Hwy 82 near Sherman. Turn right (East) on Hwy 82. Go approximately 22.5 miles and take a Right onto County Road 1264. County Road 1264 is now closed to the public and has two entrances, do NOT use the first entrance. Go into the second entrance of County Road 1264, through the green gate, closing it behind you if it's closed, and follow the banners.
